Satan's main agenda is to have the world believe that the law of God is not binding. Thus he keeps people ignorant of the fact that they are sinners and in need of a Saviour. In this way he is leading millions to reject the gift of salvation that has been purchased with the blood of God's only begotten Son.

If we love God, we will love to obey Him and will be in harmony with His law. (See John 14:15; 1 John 5:3.) It is when our love for God wanes that we start dwelling on outward acts. (See Matt. 23:25.)
