The conditions of eternal life, under grace, are just what they were in the beginning in Eden - perfect harmony with God through conformity to His law.

Law and grace are as closely knit together as Christ is to the cross. As it is the law that triggers the need for grace.

Jesus said "if you love me keep my commandments." And seeing that He and the Father are one then the Ten Commandments are also Jesus' Commandments.

Just think - if God could have cancelled His law then Jesus would never have needed suffer death on the cross in place of humanity's transgression of God's law.
